developed to wash garments gently in lower temperatures, using 50 per cent less detergent and 70 per cent less water than conventional machines, whilst still cleaning fabrics to a high standard.

There are also the added benefits for spa owners of reducing energy and water costs and improving their 'green' credentials.

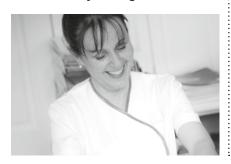
Hot stone massage is also being offered with all spa massage treatments to add that extra element of relaxation. Other treatments you could offer
